<p><u>Intent</u> is to capture information on consumers/family members who provide primary health issues (such as addressing and managing diabetes, hypertension, cardiovascular disease and respiratory health, dental hygiene, etc.).</p> <p>Obesity and psychotropic meds, Smoking/tobacco cessation, medication management, HIV/AIDS training, management, trauma informed care, or assessment) are consistent with the goals of the grant.</p> <p><u>“Screening”</u> refers to initial identification of those in need for intervention; it does not include routine follow-up for the purpose of monitoring a consumer’s progress or status.</p>	<p><u>Screened</u> is identifying or differentiating individuals who may be in need of specific interventions according to established criteria.</p> <p><u>Primary Care or Related</u> refers to chronic physical conditions or the population of people with or at risk of chronic physical conditions who also have a serious mental illness; also includes people with co-occurring substance use disorders.</p> <p><u>Interventions</u> include treatment, rehabilitation, primary care and/or related promotion and supportive services, culturally-specific practices, suicide prevention programs, &amp; rural tele-health programs.</p>	<p><u>Information to Count:</u> The number of individuals screened for an initial identification of a need for intervention.</p> <p>This will most likely consist of the individual being screened initially for enrollment into the PBHCI program. Also, if you have active clients who got screened for the first time for a need that wasn’t identified before, they can count.</p> <p><u>COUNT</u> The number of individuals; <b>NOT</b> the number of interventions.</p>	<p><b>On the Result Form</b>, enter the following information in the quarter when the individual was screened:</p> <p><u>Result Name:</u> Enter the name/title of the screening provided.</p> <p><u>Result Description:</u> Enter description (1-3 sentences) on 1) Who received the received and 2) Type of screening provided.</p> <p><u>Result Number:</u> Enter the total number of individuals screened.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>EXAMPLE</b></p> <p><b>Result Name:</b> Health Fair Diabetes Screens <b>Result Description:</b> We screened 50 individuals at the Waterford Health Fair this quarter for their risk of having diabetes. <b>Number:</b> 50</p> <p><b>Result Name:</b> Initial Depression Screenings <b>Result Description:</b> We screened 20 current patients for</p>	<p><b>NO, DO NOT COUNT</b></p> <p>Ongoing monitoring to assess individuals progress and status</p> <p>The number of interventions</p> <p><b>YES, COUNT ONLY</b></p> <p>Only those individuals screen for initial identification of a need for intervention</p>
