<p><u>Intent</u> is to capture information on improvements in the workforce in addressing primary health issues (such as addressing and managing diabetes, hypertension, cardiovascular disease and respiratory health, dental hygiene, etc.).</p> <p>Obesity and psychotropic meds, Smoking/tobacco cessation, medication management, HIV/AIDS training, management, trauma informed care, or assessment) are consistent with</p>	<p><u>Credentialed/Certified</u> refers to licenses or certified trainings that provide qualifications for primary care or related practices/activities; often a test must be passed. Examples include: Certified Co-occurring Disorders Professional (CCDP); Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW); Nurse Practitioner (RN); Wellness Recovery and Action Plan (WRAP) facilitator, Peer support specialist, tobacco cessation specialist, etc.</p> <p><u>Primary Care or Related</u> refers to chronic physical conditions or the population of people with or at risk of chronic physical conditions who also have a serious mental illness; also includes people with co-occurring substance use disorders.</p> <p><u>Practices/Activities</u> include treatment, rehabilitation, prevention, primary care or related promotion & supportive services, & culturally-specific practices.</p> <p><u>Grant</u> means to report only on the grant identified by the Grant ID listed on the Result Record.</p>	<p><u>Information to Count:</u> The number of people newly credentialed or certified during the quarter.</p> <p>DO NOT count the number of credentials/certifications.</p>	<p>On the Result Form, enter the following information:</p> <p><u>Result Name:</u> Enter the Name of the Credential or Certification.</p> <p><u>Result Description:</u> Enter description (1-3 sentences) on 1) number of people receiving the credential or certification 2) what the credential or certification was.</p> <p><u>Number:</u> Enter the number of people who received that particular credential or certification.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">EXAMPLES</p> <p>Result Name: Tobacco cessation certification Result Description: The agency paid for 2 staff members to become tobacco cessation specialists, which resulted in billable services. One staff person is a clinical social worker and the other is the nurse practitioner. They attended a tobacco cessation certification training. Number: 2</p> <p>Result Name: Peer Support Specialist Result Description: The agency sent three individuals this quarter to a six-month training to receive certification as a peer support specialist.</p>	<p>NO, DO NOT COUNT</p> <p>The number the credential/certifications.</p> <p>YES, COUNT ONLY</p> <p>The number of individuals credentialed or certified.</p>
