<p><u>Intent</u> is to capture information on consumers/family members who provide primary health issues (such as addressing and managing diabetes, hypertension, cardiovascular disease and respiratory health, dental hygiene, etc.).</p> <p>Obesity and psychotropic meds, Smoking/tobacco cessation, medication management, HIV/AIDS training, management, trauma informed care, or assessment) are consistent with</p>	<p><u>Consumers</u> are adults who currently receive primary care services, have received primary care services, or are eligible to receive primary care services.</p> <p><u>Family Members</u> may be members of an adult consumer's immediate or extended family. Family members may also be friends, co-workers, or neighbors of a consumer.</p> <p><u>Primary Care or Related</u> refers to chronic physical conditions or the population of people with or at risk of chronic physical conditions who also have a serious mental illness; also includes people with co-occurring substance use disorders.</p> <p><u>Services</u> include treatment, rehabilitation, prevention, primary care and/or related promotion and supportive services, culturally-specific practices; suicide prevention programs; &amp; rural tele-health programs.</p>	<p><u>Information to Count:</u></p> <p>The number of consumers or family members providing mental health-related services. This can be paid or unpaid positions.</p> <p>DO NOT count consumers or family members involved exclusively in planning and advocacy activities or mental health-related evaluation oversight, data collection, and/or analysis activities. <i>This is counted in IPP indicator A6.</i></p>	<p><b>On the Result Form</b>, enter the following information:</p> <p><u>Result Name:</u> Enter a Quick Phrase About the Activity that Resulted in a consumer or family member providing services.</p> <p><u>Result Description:</u> Enter description (1-3 sentences) on 1) if new hire is a consumer or family member and 2) job title.</p> <p><u>Number:</u> Enter the number of individuals who meet these criteria specified in the Result Description.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>EXAMPLES</b></p> <p><b>Result Name:</b> Hired Peer Support Specialist  <b>Result Description:</b> We added a peer support specialist to three treatment teams this quarter.  <b>Number:</b> 3</p> <p><b>Result Name:</b> Outreach and Engagement Peers  <b>Result Description:</b> 3 peers conduct outreach and engagement through phone calls, home visits; provide transportation and conduct interviews with clients for the PBHCI program.  <b>Number:</b> 3</p> <p><b>Result Name:</b> Peer Navigators</p>	<p><b>NO, DO NOT COUNT</b></p> <p>Consumers or family members involved exclusively in planning, advocacy, evaluation oversight, data collection, and/or analysis activities.</p> <p><b>YES, COUNT ONLY</b></p> <p>The number of consumers or family members providing primary care or related services.</p>
