

Question by Question Guide- Section H –Program Specific Questions (MAI-CoC):

Answer these questions from the medical record, or documentation of medical evidence provided with the permission of the client. A client with a pre-existing HIV positive status should not be retested for HIV.

For all clients, answer question one. The remainder of the questions (2-8) will only be answered pertaining to clients who are HIV positive, whether the HIV positive status is a pre-existing diagnosis prior to this treatment episode, or a new diagnosis.

1. **Report at baseline only:** What is the client's current HIV status?

- Positive/Reactive Negative/Non-reactive
 Unknown

If this is a baseline 'interview', and the answer to question one is 'Negative/Non-reactive' or 'Unknown', the interview is 'complete', and you skip the remainder of the questions. *These questions (2-8) will fade on the screen if the response to question one is Negative/Non-reactive.*

If this is a reassessment interview, go to Section I. If this is a discharge interview, go to Section J.

If the answer to question one is Positive/Reactive, answer Questions 2-8 from the medical record.

2. **Report at baseline only:** Has the client been diagnosed HIV positive, prior to this assessment?

- No, this was a new HIV diagnosis Yes, the client had been previously diagnosed as HIV positive prior to this assessment.

3. **Report at baseline and all reassessments:** Has the client been prescribed antiretroviral therapy (ART) in the past 6 months, including at this assessment?

4. **Report at baseline only:** Had the client been prescribed ART PRIOR to this assessment?

- Yes, and the client had a current prescription for ART at the time of this assessment.

5. **Report at first reassessment only:** Did the client attend a routine HIV medical care visit within three months of HIV diagnosis?
